UK-German Connection activity report Dee Bank School, Chester – Schule an der Kleiststrasse, Oldenburg Wingate Centre 24/09/2018 – 28/09/2018

On Monday the Students and staff travelled from Schule an der Kleiststrasse and Dee Banks. Everyone arrived after lunch and had time to get used to the Wingate Centre, explore the grounds and unpack. We returned to the Wingate for evening meal and then drove to Chester to watch a circus show that was designed for children with SEN. The children seemed to really enjoy the performance.



On Friday we had a Yoga session with Ros from Dee Banks School and then students and staff had time to gather and pack belongings ready to travel home. The students were able to have free time to explore the grounds, relax in the lounge area and say their goodbye's to the friends they had made.



We all thoroughly enjoyed our stay at the Wingate Centre, the staff were very accommodating and wanted to help in any way they could. The students at Dee Banks continue to talk about the residential and how much they enjoyed their stay and meeting new friends from Schule an der Kleiststrasse.
